



Information for skiavoriaz.co.uk guests

Welcome to our apartment. We hope you had a good journey and are ready to enjoy the delights of skiing in this region. The following information is to help you make the most of your stay.

Linen

You should have a full linen supply – sheets, duvet covers, towels & tea towels. If anything is missing please contact our service company Christopher Brouesse on [+33 603598058](tel:+33603598058) or at his “shop” which is opposite the ice rink in the resort. The shop has a sign “Pole Location Services” above the shop.

Provisions

We have left a range of items in the cupboard including some herbs and spices and a basic first aid kit. Please feel free to use any of these.

Games & Books

There is a box of games and plastic sledges in the cupboard in the hall & books/DVDs on the shelf in the lounge for your use.

Fire

Your attention is drawn to the fire instructions opposite the lift door in the corridor. The fire escape is half way down the corridor and the fire alarm is just behind this door.



Getting to the Village Centre

As you leave the door to the Aster Residence turn left and go over the bridge to the door marked Ascenseur Public . At the end of the corridor there is a lift down. Leave the lift and walk across to the door again signed Asenseur Public . Again the lift is at the end of the corridor. At the bottom of the lift you are in the main centre.



Ski Shop

The MirFamose ski shop is directly opposite the lift in the centre. Take one of the cards in our information book and they will offer 40% discount to the public prices – alternatively you can mention you are staying in Aster 305 and my name Bernie Campbell. If you have pre-ordered then let someone know as you arrive. If your skis need waxing during the week they will do this free of charge if you hire from them.

Ski Lockers

The ski locker room is on the ground floor and our locker has the room number 305 on it. If you leave your boots on the spikes overnight they will be warm and dry in the morning. Please keep the locker locked if you are not using it. The access code to the locker room is the same code as the Aster code.

Supermarket

The Sherpa supermarket is well stocked and very friendly. Information on the shop is contained in our information book – attention is drawn to their offer of a pierrade (hot stone) or fondue which you can have for the evening if you book in advance and buy the meat from them.



Restaurants

There are a number of restaurants in the village centre. See recommendations in the guest restaurant recommendation book found under the TV. Add some of your own.

Tourist Office

If you walk past Mir Famose up the hill the tourist office is on the left after the merry go round. Here you can find out what activities during the week are being organised by the resort . At Christmas and New Year the fireworks are a highlight – enjoy a free Vin Chaud in the centre then return to the Apartment for a great view of the fireworks in Avoriaz, Morzine and Les Gets.

Lift Passes

If you have not received your tickets using the highly recommended pre-booking service on the internet then you will need to get your tickets from one of the 2 ticket stations in the village. There is one in the main centre past the Tourist Office and the other is at the Prodains Telepherique Station – which can be skied to on your first morning from the apartment. (see skiing suggestions).

Internet

There is wireless internet in the apartment . The resort internet system will block the apartment's internet if “unreasonable use” is detected and there is a 50 euro charge to unblock the connection chargeable to your security deposit. Details of the rules of internet usage are provided in this folder and should be read before you use the internet. Since moving to fibre optics connection down the mountain the rules are much less severe and the speed a lot better. The access codes are in this folder (see section after this).

Bins

You can empty your bin in the room marked Poubelle along the corridor. The rubbish should be separated as per the diagrams on the wall.

Dishwasher

There should be dishwasher salt and rinse aid under the sink if the indicator lights on the dishwasher show. Please top up as required. The filter should be cleaned at the end of the week.
